The activities we offer at **Summer on the Farm** are extremely experiential for all students of every age group and are in accordance with the European environmental framework set out in the Europe 2030 Agenda.

**Our greatest asset is our educational farm**  
and its production facilities.

Our daily activities are made up of games, sports and arts.

Every age group has its own varied program, based on its developmental stage and needs.

Through experiential activities, workshops and experiments, we address current global issues, such as climate change, the origins of food, the essentials of life, lessening food waste, sustainable farming practices, water and resource conservation, recycling, and upcycling.

The following is a brief description of our three age groups.

## For Preschoolers – Toddlers

### “Getting to Know the Farm with our Friend, Farmeraki”

Farmeraki will take the leading role in our Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten groups.

With his guidance and instructions, Farmeraki will introduce the children to the farm more and more each day. He will give them chores to do with our farm animals – the cows, chickens, bees, and snails, and send them on missions around the gardens and barns too.

Basic cooking, experiments, growing and picking vegetables, exploring the earth, pottery, art, story-telling and story-sharing are only a few of the many activities the kids will be taking part in with Farmeraki, who will be accompanying them everywhere they go.

Throughout our time together, our children will learn about the wonders of water, clean air, food that shouldn't be thrown away, and much more about the environment. And finally, on the last day, Farmeraki will present the kids with a certificate!

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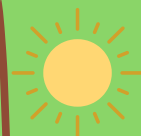
For students of Grades 1-3

## “Earth, Water, Air and Light! In other words, how is life created?”

This age group will ponder and try to find answers to great questions like: What is our body made up of? What are the essential elements that sustain life? What do we need **EARTH** for? How can we save **WATER**? What are the strengths of the **AIR** and how can we clean it up? Can we imagine a day without **LIGHT**? How is life sustained? What is needed to grow healthy food?

The farm, its productions and everything on it will give the children food for thought and action.

We will explore the farm animals and plants, cook simple but delicious food, work in labs and take part in experiments focusing on the environment and our home, create pottery and art, and play many games too - with **Earthy, Watery, Airy** and **Sunbeam!**

## “Entrepreneurship: Food and Sustainable Means of Production” & “Working for our Environment and Community”

Our older kids will focus on the above subjects in thematically based weeks.

The farm will be our integral field of action, where the kids will learn about its facilities and what it produces. Some of the activities include experiential workshops, experiments, research, and meetings for the exchange of ideas, opinions and arguments, teamwork and product creation. Our goal is to understand and apply ideas such as sustainable means of food production, conservation of water resources, ways to reduce food waste, and climate change, and to ultimately come up with a framework for communal accountability.

Our program is made complete with pottery workshops, hands-on first aid classes and games in the school's sports fields.
