

How do we spend our day on the farm?

To get an idea of what a typical day is like on the farm, here is a description in the kids' own words:

7.30-8.45: We slowly get together. We play team games in the woods by the campus church until all the children arrive. Our team leaders are always with us.

8.45-9.00: We all get into our groups, talk about the daily program, and then we go to the dining area for breakfast.

9.10-9.40: We have plenty of time to finish our breakfast.

9.40-12.45: We settle down in our “**stations for the day**” and start our activities. There's a lot to do on the farm today! But there's always time to play.

12.30-13.30: It's noon! We're hungry! What treats are there on the menu for us today?

13.45-14.15: We still have time for one more activity or game.

14.15-14.30: It is time to collect our materials and put them away for the next team. Have we packed all our things? Backpack, hat, water bottle!

14.30-14.50: Those of us kids who get picked up by our parents gather in the "P.PANTELIADIS" building. We form small groups and play board or team games, paint or do anything else we might come up with. Our parents can pick us up after they finish work, between 15.00 to 16.00.

14.40-15.00: Kids who take the bus home go to the parking area in the church grove and get on the bus.

CAREFUL! We mustn't forget our backpack with our hat, water bottle and insect repellent. We should also write our name on them, so they can be given back to us if we leave anything behind.
