Services offered:

- ✓ **Meals:** breakfast, fruit, juice, and a complete lunch in the Farm School cafeteria
- ✓ **Insurance coverage** for the children (Allianz)
- ✓ **Pediatrician** - available throughout the program (8.00-16.00)
- ✓ **Transportation** - Transfer services available throughout the urban area, with an escort present at all times. Our priorities in planning the bus routes are the children's safety and securing the quickest possible routes.

Children's groups - staffing - supervision

Children are separated into small groups according to age. Each group is led by three staff members, who have a background in education. In addition to this, three additional educators always supervise the groups and ensure that educational activities are carried out.

The Program

The program is organized into 3 age groups:

1st: Prekindergarten – Kindergarten **2nd:** Grades 1-2 & 3-4 (Elementary School) **3rd:** Grades 5-6 & 6-7 (Elementary & Middle School)

Our summer activities offer immensely experiential activities, which mostly take place outdoors, weather permitting. Older kids (in the 3rd age group) will have the opportunity to practice their English oral skills, as each team will have one staff member who will always speak to the participants in English.
