

IMPORTANT CARE AND CONTACT ISSUES

Dear parents, welcome to Summer on the Farm!

To ensure the children's safety and comfort, and so that we may cooperate well together, please be advised of the following:

1. Children should wear casual, sporty clothes and closed sports shoes.
2. Each child should have a backpack containing:
 - a) One **full change of clothes**: underwear and clothing. Kindergarten and pre-kindergarten specifically should carry 2 full changes of clothing. It is very likely that the kids will get dirty or wet.
 - b) One small **towel**, which we may need to wipe the face with.
 - c) A **hat and sun cream** are necessary protection against the sun. You should also pack an insect repellent of your choice for daily use.
 - d) One **full refillable water bottle**, which will be refilled whenever necessary! The Farm School is free of single-use plastic water bottles.
 - e) **Wet wipes**

You are kindly requested to write your child's name on all personal items. This will help us return any items we collect daily from the various areas of the farm.

Also, **we ask that children not bring any toys or valuables with them from home.** As you know, they are often misplaced or may become cause for disagreements.

Regarding our daily communication:

1. Whenever you need to, you may contact us directly at **2310492768** or **2310492756**. If your child is unable to attend for health reasons, we urge you to inform us. We will arrange contact between you and the pediatrician of the program.
2. If you wish to be informed of your child's participation in their team and their activities, you may ask us to schedule a call with your child's group leader or a supervisor.
3. For pre-kindergarten and kindergarten: We will inform you in writing concerning the children's meals (for questions such as, 'How much did my child eat today?').

Important Notice: Children are prohibited from bringing any type of electronic image and/or audio recording device during their participation in the program and during transportation provided under our responsibility. Otherwise, such devices will be confiscated and returned to the parents. It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that children do not bring these devices with them.
